BALLENGER CREEK PARK SYNTHETIC TURF FIELD

This included close coordination with county staff and with our sub-consultants during the design and permitting process in order to meet the budget and compressed schedule demanded by the county.

BALLENGER CREEK TRAIL

2019

Mr. Rohde coordinated the planning, design and construction of several phases of this first trail system in Frederick County. He managed the design teams for each phase, working with county DPR and DPW staff and SHA liaisons who were administering the Transportation Enhancement Program (TEP) funding for Phases 3 and 4. Mr. Rohde also oversaw the preparation of the TEP grant applications, wetlands delineations, MDE application for construction of a pedestrian bridge over Ballenger Creek, and preparation of the construction documents. He coordinated with the county and our geotechnical engineers to develop a trail pavement section suitable for floodplain soils. He also provided construction administration services for Phases 1, 3 and 4, with construction of the final section completed in 2019.

GOUGH PARK
